

# SPEEDWATCH

**Are you concerned over the speed at which many vehicles travel through the village?**

**Would you like to see vehicle speeds reduced through the village?**

**Would you be prepared to take an active role in this and help reduce vehicle speed?**

Speedwatch is a scheme run in partnership between Neighbourhood Police teams, Parish Councils and local residents.

The scheme allows the public to get actively involved in monitoring vehicle speed.

Volunteers are trained to use speed indicator devices which display vehicle speed. The registered owner of any vehicle seen exceeding the speed limit will be sent a letter from their local neighbourhood policing team, identifying when and where they exceeded the speed limit.



If you would like to be involved in this and be trained to use the equipment and carry out some speedwatch sessions then please contact us.

We are also looking for someone who can act as the village co-ordinator for this project, to book the equipment, arrange monitoring days and liaise with the volunteers involved.
